Florida Equity, Equality & Justice Influencer Award

On September 28, 2020, the Leadership Florida Board of Directors approved the Special Council Framework and Goals, which included the creation of this annual award to recognize organizations doing outstanding work in equity, equality and justice.

The Florida Equity, Equality & Justice Influencer Award recognizes a business or nonprofit organization that has demonstrated leadership in Equity, Equality, & Justice by changing their company, community, or Florida in two or more of the following areas:

- » Boards and Senior Leadership Team
- » Pipeline Development, Supplier Development
- » Pay Decision Making
- » Justice in Housing/Education/Criminal Justice Systems
- » Philanthropy in Time/Talent/Treasure

***Nominee must be a current Leadership Florida member's organization.**

Florida Impact Award

The Florida Impact Award (previously Statewide Community Award) recognizes a business or nonprofit organization that has created a specific project or body of work whose impact is currently transforming the future of its Region or beyond and has the potential to transform Florida as a whole.

***Nominee does not need to be a Leadership Florida member**

LeRoy Collins Lifetime Achievement Award

In recognition of the impeccable standards Governor LeRoy Collins set for leadership in our state, in 1991 the Lifetime Achievement Award was renamed in his honor. The purpose of this award is to recognize an individual who, like Governor Collins, has gone above and beyond by using their leadership abilities over a lifetime to improve the quality of life for all Florida citizens and its future generations.

***Nominee does not need to be a Leadership Florida member**

***If a non-member wins this award, they will become an Honorary Member of Leadership Florida**

"but for" Leadership Florida Award

This award recognizes a Leadership Florida member who has used specific knowledge gained and/or relationships built through their Leadership Florida experiences to improve the lives of fellow Floridians and create "but for" moments. In addition to the honor itself, Leadership Florida will make a donation of \$2,500 to the recipient's organization of choice, subject to the approval of the Board of Directors.

***Nominee must be a current Leadership Florida member**

Distinguished Member Award

The purpose of the Leadership Florida Distinguished Member Award is to recognize a Leadership Florida member whose continued leadership activities, outside of their professional responsibilities, have exemplified the highest standards of Leadership Florida and whose activities achieved results or set an example of statewide influence.

How do I submit a nomination?

Nominators for all awards must be current Leadership Florida Members. Nominations for the 2022 Leadership Florida awards will open on March 1 and will close on March 31 at 12:00 PM EST. All nominations must be submitted through the Leadership Florida official nomination form, which are all linked below.

No. A member may only win one award.

May an award be submitted posthumously?

No. All nominees must be living.

May I submit a self-nomination?

Yes. Self-nominations are allowed.

Who is eligible to be nominated for each award?

Nominees for the Distinguished Member Award and the "but for" Leadership Florida Award must be current Leadership Florida Members. Nominees for the Leroy Collins Lifetime Achievement Award do not need to be Leadership Florida Members.

When are Award winners announced?

Recipients of each award will be announced during the Annual Meeting at Universal's Loews Sapphire Falls Resort. - June 23-26, 2022.
